The proposed project is located at 1616 Rhode Island Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20036.

Bill 17-588, introduced by Chairman Gray at the request of the Mayor, would accept a dedication of land for street purposes, approve the establishment of a building restriction line, and order the removal of a portion of a planned right-of-way on Lot 822 in Square 1346, in the vicinity of Foxhall Road, N.W., and W Street, N.W., in Ward 3. The applicant, Phillips Park LLC, seeks these modifications to provide a southbound left-turn lane and a northbound acceleration lane at the intersection of the existing 33-foot-wide roadway, Foxhall Road, N.W., and W Street, N.W., where a residential development of 46 luxury single family homes has recently been constructed. The proposal includes a four-foot-wide grass strip, six-foot-wide sidewalk, and a new right-of-way along the edge of the sidewalk.
