THE RETIRED FIRE FIGHTER MEMBER OF THE BOARD**

The District of Columbia Retirement Reform Act (Pub. L. 96-122), effective November 17, 1979, at section 121(b), (D.C. Official Code § 1-711(b)) requires the District of Columbia Retirement Board ("Board") to conduct elections of the beneficiary and participant representatives to the Board. The Board through the American Arbitration Association (the "A.A.A."), in accordance with the Rules for the Election of Members to the D.C. Retirement Board promulgated by the Board, 30 DCR 4333-4345, as amended, conducted an election for the representatives of the retired District fire fighters.

Counting of the ballots took place on Monday, November 12, 2007, at the A.A.A. office, located at 1776 Eye Street, N.W., Suite 850, Washington, D.C., in the presence of a Board representative, and under the supervision of A.A.A.

Pursuant to section 408.1 of the rules for the Election of Members to the D.C. Retirement Board (the "election rules") A.A.A. submitted a Certification of Results which was received on November 14, 2007. Based on this Certification and pursuant to sections 408.2 and 408.3 of the election rules, the Board hereby certifies the results of the election and declares the winner to be Thomas N. Tippett, a retired District of Columbia fire fighter.

Pursuant to section 408.4 of the Election Rules, any qualified candidate for the election may petition the Board in writing for a recount of votes within seven (7) calendar days of the date of publication of the certification of the winner. The petition must be filed at the Board's executive office located at 900 7<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Washington, D.C. 20001. In the absence of a request for a recount, the election results will become final and can not be appealed thirty (30) days after the above date of publication of the certification of the winner.
