Councilmember Jim Graham, Chairperson of the Committee on Public Works and the Environment, will convene a public hearing on B17-506, the "Vending Consolidation of Public Space Authority at the Department of Transportation Amendment Act of 2007". The public hearing will be held on Friday, December 14, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. in Room 412 of the Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20004. **This hearing notice has been abbreviated to provide notice to the public.**

B17-506 would authorize the Director of the Department of Transportation to designate street vending sites, charge street vendors rental fees, issue public space occupancy permits to street vendors, establish insurance requirements for the use of public space by street vendors, waive vending stand locations, develop design standards for vending stands, food carts and roadway vehicles; and authorize the Director of the Department of Transportation to authorize and issue public space occupancy permits and charge public space rental fees to vendors and for sidewalk cafes.

The Committee invites the public to testify or to submit written testimony, which will be made a part of the official record. Councilmember Jim Graham, Chairperson of the Committee on Public Works and the Environment, will convene a public hearing on B17-0099, the "Clean Cars Act of 2007".

Pollution from cars, trucks, and vans is the leading cause of ozone and smog in the District, causing respiratory illness and childhood asthma. This public hearing will discuss implementation of the cleaner and more efficient California tailpipe emissions standard for all new cars registered in the District. The public hearing will begin either at 5:00 PM, or immediately following the public hearing on B17-437, the "Fire Hydrant Inspection, Repair, and Maintenance Amendment Act of 2007". **The September 26, 2007 public hearing on B17-0099 is being repeated due to notice not appearing in the DC Register for that public hearing. The record from the September 26, 2007 public hearing will be incorporated by reference. Additionally, this notice has been revised to reflect a new hearing date and time.**
