Notice is hereby given that a public hearing will be held on Tuesday, January 8, 2008 at 6:00 p.m. in the 6<sup>th</sup> Floor conference room at 51 N Street, NE, Washington, D.C. This hearing provides interested parties an opportunity to comment on proposed State Implementation Plan revisions regarding certain Clean Air Act (CAA) requirements under sections 110(a)(2)(D)(i) and 110(a)(2)(A)-(M).

A State Implementation Plan (SIP) identifies how each state will attain and/or maintain the primary and secondary National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The SIP is a complex, fluid document containing regulations, source-specific requirements, non-regulatory items such as plans and inventories, and in some cases, additional requirements promulgated by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The initial SIPs for states were approved on May 31, 1972, however, SIPs are under continuous revision as new standards and rules are implemented. The federally enforceable SIP for the District of Columbia is compiled in 40 CFR Part 52 Subpart J.

This SIP revision is a compilation of elements that describe how the District of Columbia is implementing the eight-hour ozone NAAQS. The elements of this SIP revision, once approved by EPA, will provide a federally enforceable written confirmation of how the District of Columbia will continue to comply with the Section 110(a)(2) requirements of the CAA.

This SIP revision plans to incorporate two (2) separate provisions:

1) To meet the requirements of the "good neighbor" provisions of Section 110(a)(2)(D)(i) of the CAA, related to interstate pollution transport for the 1997 8-hour ozone and PM<sub>2.5</sub> National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). The "good neighbor" provisions of section 110(a)(2)(D)(i) require the District of Columbia to submit a SIP that contains adequate provisions prohibiting any source or other type of emissions activity within the State from emitting any air pollutant in amounts which will contribute significantly to nonattainment in, or interfere with maintenance by, any other State with respect to any national primary or secondary air quality standard.

2) To meet the requirements of Section 110(a)(2)(A)-(M) of the CAA which have not been previously addressed. The requirements of Section 110(a)(2)(A)-(M) relate to: enforceable emission limits and schedules for compliance; monitoring, source testing and emissions reporting; recordkeeping and reporting requirements; and permit fees. Some requirements, such as those for intergovernmental consultation, air quality modeling and compliance with part D of the CAA, are fulfilled during the development and submission of SIP attainment plans.
