B17-270 would establish a new process for graffiti abatement by property owners and the Mayor; provide that certain actions by a property owner will be deemed to provide consent to permit the Mayor to abate graffiti; establish an expedited process for adjudication of any notices of violation issued for failure to abate graffiti; provide for the payment of abatement costs and penalties; establish a graffiti abatement fund; provide for liens against property involved in unresolved graffiti violations; provide graffiti abatement kits; provide limited immunity from liability for the District government in connection with graffiti abatement activities; increase the reward for providing information leading to the conviction of someone for a graffiti-related offence; make it a crime to sell certain graffiti materials to minors; establish penalties; and make conforming amendments.
