The public hearing will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, October 18, 2007 in Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building.

The stated purpose of this bill is to amend Title 16 of the D.C. Official Code to revise definitions, to require support orders to contain provisions for health care insurance coverage and cash medical support, to require one or both parents to obtain health insurance coverage for a child subject to a support order if the health insurance coverage is accessible and available at a reasonable cost, to amend the definition of reasonable cost for health insurance coverage, to include contributions associated with public and private health insurance coverage in the definition of extraordinary medical expenses, and to require the review and modification of support orders every three years in cases where there has been an assignment of support rights under the D.C. Public Assistance Act of 1983; and to amend the Medical Support Establishment and Enforcement Amendment Act of 2004 to update definitions and revise the priority for the withholding of different types of support obligations.

Bill 17-113 would amend the Department of Motor Vehicles Establishment Act of 1998 to establish a mechanism under which out-of-state drivers who were permitted by the Department to register vehicles in the District of Columbia prior to March 1, 2006 may continue to do so for so long as these drivers are otherwise eligible to register a vehicle in the District. The Committee held a public hearing on Bill 17-113 on May 18, 2007. The purpose of this hearing is to give further consideration to this permanent legislation in light of emergency and temporary legislation on the issue currently in place.
