Councilmember Jack Evans, Chairperson of the Committee on Finance and Revenue, announces a public hearing on Bill 17-72, the "Multi-Unit Real Estate Tax Rate Clarification Act of 2007", and Bill 17-73, the "District Funds Reserved Act of 2007". The public hearing will be held on Monday, March 19, 2007 at 2:00 p.m. in Room 120 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20004.

Bill 17-72, the "Multi-Unit Real Estate Tax Rate Clarification Act of 2007" would amend section 47-820 of the District of Columbia Official Code to provide that the fair market value of multi-unit residential real estate leased primarily to residential tenants shall be determined without regard to its potential for conversion to condominium or cooperative ownership.

Bill 17-73, the "District Funds Reserved Act of 2007" would amend section 47-351.11 of the District of Columbia Official Code to increase from 1% to 10% the amount of District funds deposited in one or more insured financial institutions located in the District that have less than \$350 million in assets.

The Committee invites the public to testify at the hearing. Additional written statements are encouraged and will be made part of the official record. The hearing record will close ten days following the conclusion of the hearing. Persons submitting written statements for the record should observe this deadline.
