ABBREVIATED NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER LEGISLATION

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice of its intention to take action in less than fifteen (15) days on PR16-619, the "District of Columbia Sports and Entertainment Commission and Baseball Expos, L.P. Lease Agreement Approval Resolution of 2006" in order to consider the proposed resolution at the legislative meeting scheduled for Tuesday, February 7, 2006. The Council needs to act on this resolution expeditiously to approve the lease agreement in order to avoid delays in the planning and construction of the ballpark.
