
SUBJECT: Appointment of Chairperson, Vice Chairperson and Members of the One Fund Executive Committee and Delegation of Authority to Accept Donations and Enter into Agreements regarding the 51st D.C. One Fund Drive.

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by the introductory to section 422 and sections 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22 and 1-204.22(6) and (11) (2001), and pursuant to section 4602 of The Acceptance and Use of Gifts Act of 2000 D.C. Law 13-172, effective October 19, 2000, D.C. Official Code § 1-329.01 and Mayor's Order 88-194, dated August 23, 1988, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Carol Mitten, Director, Office of Property Management, is appointed Chairperson of the D.C. One Fund Executive Committee, and is delegated authority to approve the acceptance and use of gifts or donations for the operation and administration of the 51st D.C. One Fund Drive and may enter into any agreements governing the operations of the 51st D.C. One Fund Drive.
2. Adrian H. Thompson, Fire Chief, Fire and Emergency Medical Service, is appointed Vice Chairperson of the One Fund Executive Committee, and is delegated authority to approve the acceptance and use of gifts or donations for the operation and administration of the 51st D.C. One Fund Drive, and to enter into any agreements governing the operations of the 51st D.C. One Fund Drive.
3. Pursuant to Mayor's Order 88-194, dated August 23, 1988, the One Fund Executive Committee for the 51st annual D.C. Government Employees' One Fund Drive shall be composed of the following agency heads or their designees: Office of Cable Television and Telecommunications, Office of the Chief Financial Officer, Office of the Chief Technology Officer, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, Department of Employment Services, Department of Human Services, Fire and Emergency Medical Service, Department of Public Works, Department of Motor Vehicles, Office of the Attorney General, and DC Office of Personnel.

4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to October 1, 2005.



Official Code § 1-204.22(6) (2001), and the Vacant and Abandoned Properties Community Development and Disapproval of Disposition of Certain Scattered Vacant and Abandoned Properties Act of 2002 ("the Act"), D.C. Law 14-267, D.C. Official Code § 10-831 *et seq.* (2004 Supp.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:


SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority - Retail Incentive Act of 2004
