Cropp announces the rescheduling of a public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on Bill 16-593, the "Closing of a Portion of "S" Street, S.E., a portion of 13th Street, S.E., and Public Alleys in Squares 5600 and 5601, S.O. 04-11912, Act of 2006." The public hearing is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 14, 2006, in the Council Chamber, Room 500 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW.

Bill 16-593, introduced by Chairman Cropp at the request of the Mayor, would close a portion of S Street, S.E., a portion of 13th Street, S.E., and public alleys in Squares 5600 and 5601, bounded by Martin Luther King Jr. Avenue, S.E., Good Hope Road, S.E., and 13th Street, S.E., in Ward 8. The applicant is the D.C. Office of Property Management which seeks the closings to facilitate the development of the Anacostia Gateway Government Center, which will include two interconnected office buildings for the District Department of Transportation with underground parking.

Bill 16-605, introduced at the request of the Mayor, would amend the "Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund Establishment Act of 1999" to authorize and otherwise provide for the transfer of certain monies to the Tobacco Settlement Financing Corporation, and would amend the "Tobacco Settlement Financing Act of 2000" to authorize the Tobacco Settlement Financing Corporation to issue additional bonds to finance the costs of the National Capital Medical Center or other capital projects.

PR 16-637, introduced at the request of the Mayor, would approve the District of Columbia Tobacco Settlement Financing Corporation's issuance of Tobacco Settlement Asset-Backed Bonds to finance capital projects and other undertakings of the District, including the National Capital Medical Center.
