The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice of its intention to take action in less than fifteen (15) days on PR 16-775, the "Compensation Agreement for the Department of Mental Health Employees and Psychologists Union, of the District of Columbia Department of Mental Health, Local 3758, 1199 National Union of Hospital and Health Care Employees, American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees, AFL – CIO Approval Resolution of 2006," in order to consider the proposed resolution at an additional legislative meeting on May 16, 2006.
