Councilmember Phil Mendelson, Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary, announces a public hearing on Bill 16-746, "Criminal Record Expungement Act of 2006." The hearing will be held on Thursday, July 13, 2006, at 10:00 a.m., in the 5th Floor Council Chamber of the John A. Wilson Building located at 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C.

The stated purpose of Bill 16-746 is to create a process to expunge and/or seal certain criminal records in cases of actual innocence and certain misdemeanors and felonies in the District of Columbia.

The purpose of this hearing is to receive testimony from the government and the public on this bill. Copies of the bill may be obtained from the Council's Legislative Services Division at 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20004, 202-724-8050.

Individuals should limit their testimony to five minutes; less time will be allowed if there are a large number of witnesses.
