Councilmember Jim Graham, Chairperson of the Committee on Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, will convene a public hearing on Bill 16-696, the "On-Premises Retailer's License Act of 2006". This notice is abbreviated to expeditiously address this issue of pressing public and licensee concern.

Bill 16-696 would amend section 25-314(b) of the District of Columbia Official Code to allow consideration of on-premises licenses to establishments within 400 feet of a public, private, or parochial primary, elementary, or high school; college or university; or recreation area operated by the D.C. Department of Recreation.

Councilmember Phil Mendelson, Chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary, announces a public oversight roundtable on state of security at the Jail in light of the recent inmate escapes. The hearing will be held on Monday, June 26, 2006, at 10:00 a.m., in the 5th Floor Council Chamber of the John A. Wilson Building located at 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C.

On Saturday June 3, 2006, the D.C. Department of Corrections (DOC) reported the escape of two inmates from the Jail. Both inmates were apprehended within 40 hours. However, this escape exposed issues in multiple areas of DOC operations such as; assignment of work details, implementation of separation orders, prisoner clothing, and the effectiveness of the Jail's warning system to District residents.
