2. It is further ordered that the Director of the OUC is delegated the authority to execute and administer the appropriate grant agreements between Nextel and the District.
3. It is further ordered that the authority to administer the appropriate grant agreements may be further delegated by the Director of the OUC to subordinates under the jurisdiction of the Director, provided that such further delegation is limited to the authority to certify to Nextel that the District approves, for payment by Nextel, invoices by contractors with the District for work performed pursuant to the grant agreements between Nextel and the District.

Official Code § 1-204.22(6) (2001), and pursuant to the Grandparent Caregivers Pilot Program Establishment Emergency Act of 2006, effective February 22, 2006, D.C. Act 16-278 (Act), and any substantially identical successor legislation, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Director of the Child and Family Services Agency (Director) is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor pursuant to section 102 of the Act, and any substantially identical successor legislation, to establish a pilot program through which eligible grandparents, great-grandparents, great-aunts, and great-uncles may receive subsidy payments for the care and custody of a child residing in their home.
2. The Director is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor pursuant to section 106 of the Act, and any substantially identical successor legislation, to issue rules to implement the provisions of the Act.
3. The authority delegated herein to the Director may be further delegated to subordinates under the jurisdiction of the Director.
4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.


