To approve the proposed rules to revise standards for certificate of need holders for the provision of uncompensated care pursuant to the requirements of the Health Services Planning Program Re-establishment Act of 1996.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Provision of Uncompensated Care Rules Approval Resolution of 2006".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 22 of the Health Services Planning Program Re-establishment Act of 1996, effective April 9, 1997, (D.C. Law 11-191; D.C. Official Code § 44-421), the Mayor on February 17, 2006, transmitted to the Council proposed rules to replace the current standards for the provision of uncompensated care pursuant to a certificate of need. The Council approves the proposed rules to amend Chapter 44 of Title 22 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.

Sec. 3. The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, to the Mayor, the Director of the Department of Health, and the Director of the State Health Planning and Development Agency.

To approve a rulemaking to amend Chapter 18 of Title 27 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to authorize the use of small purchase procedures by the Office of Contracting and Procurement for procurements for the Office of the Chief Technology Officer.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Small Purchases for the Office of the Chief Technology Officer Amendment Approval Resolution of 2006".

Sec. 2. (a) Pursuant to section 205(b) of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act, effective February 21, 1986 (D.C. Law 6-85; D.C. Official Code § 2-302.05(b)), the Mayor transmitted to the Council a request for Council review and approval of the rulemaking proposed and adopted on an emergency basis by the Chief Procurement Officer to amend Chapter 18 of Title 27 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to authorize the Office of Contracting and Procurement to use small purchase procedures for the procurement of services and supplies for the Office of the Chief Technology Officer when the total of the procurement does not exceed \$500,000.

(b) The Council approves the final rules to amend Chapter 18 of Title 27 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations that were published at 52 DCR 8842.

Sec. 3. The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, each to the Chief Procurement Officer, the Chief Technology Officer, and the Mayor.
