Bill 16-703 would amend the Rental Housing Act of 1980 to provide protection from eviction to victims of intrafamily offenses. The bill would also provide a release from a lease should a victim's safety be in jeopardy, and prohibit housing discrimination against victims of intrafamily offenses..

The purpose of PR 16-852 is to authorize the Mayor to dispose of development rights located on the ballpark site subject to requirements set out in the resolution. The purpose of B16-627 is to impose a cap on the District's contribution to the project budget for hard costs and on the District's contribution to the project budget for certain soft costs of the proposed ballpark. The purpose of B16-765 subsections 2(h) and (k) is to allocate funds from the Operating Budget Reserve for the Executive Office of the Mayor and the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development.
