IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To approve rules to carry out the purposes of the District of Columbia Hazardous Waste Management Act of 1977.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Department of Health – Hazardous Waste Management Infractions Schedule of Fines Approval Resolution of 2006".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 104(a)(1) of the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs Civil Infractions Act of 1985, effective October 5, 1985 (D.C. Law 6-42; D.C. Official Code § 2-1801.04(a)(1)), the Council approves the proposed rules transmitted by the Mayor that amend section 3652 of Title 16 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations published at 53 DCR 2215.

Sec. 3. The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, to the Director of the Department of Health.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

June 20, 2006

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to allocate resources from the District of Columbia Operating Budget Reserve and Fund Balance.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "June Reserve Fund and Fund Balance Allocation Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2006".

Sec. 2. (a) Section 202(j)(3)(B) of the District of Columbia Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Act of 1995, approved April 17, 1995 (109 Stat. 109; D.C. Official Code § 47-392.02(j)(3)(B), and section 124(3) of the District of Columbia Appropriations Act, 2006, approved November 30, 2006 (Pub. L. No. 109-115; 119 Stat. 2519), requires that reserve funds be obligated or expended in accordance with local law enacted by the Council.

(b) The Chief Financial Officer has provided the necessary certification of availability for the allocation of \$48.388 million for one-time expenditures to be funded by the 2006 Operating Budget Reserve and \$5.1 million for one-time expenditures to be funded by the General Fund surplus for a total allocation of \$53.488 million. This total amount must be made available for expenditure immediately to meet the needs of the District of Columbia citizens.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the June Reserve Fund and Fund Balance Allocation Emergency Act of 2006 be adopted after a single reading.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
