On Thursday, September 28, 2006, Councilmember Kathy Patterson, Chairperson of the Committee on Education, Libraries and Recreation, will hold a public hearing on Bill 16-816, the "Revised Southeast Tennis and Learning Center Operations and Management Act of 2006." This legislation, which was introduced by Chairman Cropp at the request of Mayor Williams, would authorize the Department of Parks and Recreation to enter a 99-year agreement with the Recreation Wish List Committee of Washington D.C. for the operations of the Southeast Tennis and Learning Center, and waive provisions of the Procurement Practices Act with regard to the 99-year agreement. The public hearing will begin at 10 a.m. in the fifth-floor Council Chamber at 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.
