Notice of Reprogramming Request

Pursuant to DC Code Sec 47-361-et.seq of the Reprogramming Policy Act of 1990, the Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the Mayor has transmitted the following reprogramming request(s).

A reprogramming will become effective on the 15th day after official receipt unless a Member of the Council files a notice of disapproval of the request which extends the Council's review period to 30 days. If such notice is given, a reprogramming will become effective on the 31st day after its official receipt unless a resolution of approval or disapproval is adopted by the Council prior to that time.

Reprog. 16-95: Request to reprogram \$5,600,000 of capital budget authority from various projects across several agencies to the Office of Cable Television and Telecommunications (OCTT) was received in the Chairman's Office on July 26, 2006. The reprogramming will provide budget authority to OCTT so that it may purchase high definition broadcast equipment through the District's Master Equipment Lease/Purchase program.

Reprog. 16-96: Request to reprogram \$898,105 of capital funds budget authority from the Office of the City Administrator (OCA) was received in the Chairman's Office on July 27, 2006. The reprogramming will establish a new capital project that will enable OCA to perform an independent audit of the District's DCNET telecommunication network.

Reprog. 16-97: Request to reprogram \$961,653 of special purpose revenue funds budget authority within the Public Services Commission (PSC) was received in the Chairman's Office on July 27, 2006. The reprogramming will help address a liability resulting from a judgment issued by the D.C. Court of Appeals.

Reprog. 16-98: Request to reprogram \$1,587,074 of special purpose revenue funds budget authority from the Department of Health (DOH) to the Department of Human Services was received in the Chairman's Office on July 28, 2006. The reprogramming will reallocate budget authority to cover the cost of care for eligible clients within the Mental Retardation Developmental Disabilities Administration (MRDDA).
