**"Identity Theft Technical Temporary Amendment Act of 2006"**

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, P.L. 93-198 (the Charter), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill 16-574 on first and second readings January 4, 2006 and February 7, 2006, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on February 27, 2006, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Charter, the bill became Act 16-296 and was published in the March 17, 2006 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 53, page 1873). Act 16-296 was transmitted to Congress on March 8, 2006 for a 60-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(2) of the Home Rule Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 60-day Congressional review period has ended, and Act 16-296 is now D.C. Law 16-141, effective June 30, 2006.



and Records Temporary Amendment Act of 2006"**

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, P.L. 93-198 (the Charter), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill 16-698 on first and second readings April 4, 2006 and May 2, 2006, respectively. The legislation was deemed approved without the signature of the Mayor on May 19, 2006, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Charter, the bill became Act 16-387 and was published in the June 2, 2006 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 53, page 4424). Act 16-387 was transmitted to Congress on May 30, 2006 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Home Rule Act.

Following the signature of the Mayor on March 30, 2006, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Charter, the bill became Act 16-340 and was published in the April 14, 2006 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 53, page 2838). Act 16-340 was transmitted to Congress on April 5, 2006 for a 60-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(2) of the Home Rule Act.



Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, P.L. 93-198 (the Charter), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill 16-109 on first and second readings May 2, 2006 and June 6, 2006, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on June 15, 2006, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Charter, the bill became Act 16-391 and was published in the June 23, 2006 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 53, page 4889). Act 16-391 was transmitted to Congress on June 16, 2006 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Home Rule Act.
