

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


SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority – City Administrator

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422 (6) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22 (6) (2001), and pursuant to the First Amendment Assemblies Act of 2004, approved April 13, 2005, D.C. Law 15-352, D.C. Official Code § 5-331.06(d) (2006 Supp.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The City Administrator is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor to consider and decide administrative appeals from orders of the Chief of Police denying applications for permits, revoking permits prior to the dates of planned assemblies, or granting permits subject to time, place or manner restrictions deemed objectionable by the applicants.
2. This Order supersedes any prior Mayor's Order to the extent of any inconsistency therein.
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately and shall remain in effect pending further Mayor's Order.

SUBJECT: Designation of Special Event Area

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By the virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22 (11) (2001), and pursuant to 19 DCMR §1301.8 (June 2001), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Commencing September 6, 2006 through September 7, 2006, daily from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m., the streets known as "E" Street, N.W., and Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., between 13th & 14th Streets, N.W. (curb lanes), being those streets immediately to the north and south of Freedom Plaza, together with Freedom Plaza, and the north and south curb lanes of E Street N.W. between 12th and 13th Street, N.W., adjacent to Freedom Plaza, are hereby designated as special event areas to be used as a senior vending marketplace and senior festival site, and vendor/sponsor set-up areas, and shall be under the authority and use of the D.C. Office on Aging ("DCOA"). The said portion of E Street shall be closed to motor vehicle traffic except for such vehicles as may be expressly authorized to enter therein, and the said portion of Pennsylvania Avenue shall be partially closed to motor vehicle traffic as necessary to facilitate the loading and offloading of attendees, materials and supplies to Freedom Plaza.
2. The DCOA is authorized to operate said senior festival and senior vending marketplace in this designated special event area, at the times specified.
3. In the event that all or any part of the said senior festival is interrupted by adverse weather conditions on September 6 or 7, 2006, DCOA hereby is authorized to extend the said festival to September 8, 2006, under the terms and conditions described in Paragraph 1 above.

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4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.

1. The following persons are reappointed as members of the Gas Station Advisory Board (hereinafter referred to as "Board") for terms to end June 13, 2009:




