Council Chairman Linda W. Cropp announces the rescheduling of the public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on Bill 16-952, the "Closing of a Public Alley in Square 375, S.O. 06-656, Act of 2006." The public hearing, originally scheduled on Thursday, November 9, 2006, at 10:45 a.m., in the Council Chamber, is rescheduled to Wednesday, November 15, 2006, at 11:00 a.m., in Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

Bill 16-952, introduced by Councilmember Jack Evans, would close a portion of a public alley in Square 375, bounded by 9<sup>th</sup>, G, 10<sup>th</sup>, and H Streets, N.W., in Ward 2. The applicant, First Congressional United Church of Christ, the owner of Lot 823 and PN Hoffman, the developer of the project, is requesting the alley closing to facilitate the redevelopment of Lot 823. The redevelopment project's ground, second and third floors, approximately 42,700 square feet, will house church activities, and the upper floors, approximately 150,638 square feet, will be developed with residential uses.
