Council Chairman Linda W. Cropp announces a public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on Bill 16-1001, The "Biennial Mayor and Council Compensation Advisory Commission Establishment Amendment Act of 2006;" Bill 16-1002, "District of Columbia Elected Official Compensation Commission Establishment Act of 2006;" and Bill 16-1004, "Mayor and Councilmember Compensation Change Amendment Act of 2006." The public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, November 28, 2006, at 2:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W. An abbreviated notice is given in order to consider the proposed legislation in Council Period 16.

Bill 16-1001, introduced by Councilmembers Gray and Mendelson, would amend the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 to create a Biennial Mayor and Council Compensation Advisory Commission to study the compensation and benefits for elected officials by reviewing the best practices regionally and nationally of comparable jurisdictions, and to make findings and recommendations to the Mayor and Council. Bill 16-1002, introduced by Councilmembers Mendelson and Gray, would establish the District of Columbia Elected Official Compensation Commission to provide recommendations to the Council of the District of Columbia on the proper compensation for the Mayor, Chair of the Council, and Councilmembers, and other purposes. Bill 16-1004, introduced by Councilmember Orange, would amend the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 to increase the compensation for Members of the Council to \$122,530 and for the Mayor to \$200,000.
