**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING**

**TELEPHONE TARIFF 06-7, IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF VERIZON WASHINGTON, DC INC. FOR AUTHORITY TO AMEND THE GENERAL SERVICES TARIFF, P.S.C.-D.C.-NO. 203**

1. The Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia ("Commission") hereby gives notice, pursuant to D.C. Official Code Section 2-505,<sup>1</sup> of its intent to act upon the Application of Verizon Washington, DC Inc. ("Verizon DC")<sup>2</sup> in the above-captioned matter in not less than 30 days from the date of publication of this Notice of Proposed Rulemaking ("NOPR") in the *D.C. Register*.

2. On November 13, 2006, Verizon DC filed an application requesting authority to amend the following tariff page:

**GENERAL SERVICES TARIFF, P.S.C.-D.C.-NO. 203  
Section 31, 5th Revised Page 4**

3. Verizon proposes to increase the monthly recurring rates for Local Package from \$28.95 to \$30.99 (7.0%), Local Package Extra from \$31.95 to \$33.99 (6.4%), Regional Package from \$36.95 to \$38.95 (5.4%), and Regional Package Extra from \$41.95 to \$43.95 (4.8%).

4. The complete text of the tariff page is on file with the Commission. Copies of the proposed tariff page may be reviewed at the Office of the Commission Secretary, 1333 H Street, N.W., 7th Floor, East Tower, Washington, D.C. 20005, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Copies of the tariff page are available upon request, at a per-page reproduction cost.

5. Verizon has requested expedited review of this application under Chapter 35 of the Commission's rules. Comments on the proposed tariff revision must be made in writing to Dorothy Wideman, Commission Secretary, at the above address. All comments must be received within 30 days of the date of publication of this NOPR in the *D.C. Register*. Persons wishing to file reply comments may do so no later than 35 days from the date of publication of this NOPR in the *D.C. Register*. Once the comment period has expired, the Commission will take final rulemaking action on Verizon DC's application.
