Councilmember Jim Graham, Chairperson of the Committee on Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, will convene a public oversight roundtable on the report and recommendations of the TOPA Task Force, charged with the review of the District's Tenant Opportunity to Purchase Act.

In the Budget Support Act of 2005, the Council established the Rental Housing Conversion and Sale Act Task Force in the Rental Housing Conversion and Sale Amendment Act of 2005, to examine all aspects of titles IV and V of the act, including its implementation and compliance with its requirements, and to determine the best means for preserving rental housing, preventing the deterioration of the housing stock, and preventing the displacement of tenants. The Council required that the Task Force issue a report and recommendations proposing policy initiatives and revisions to the statute designed to improve titles IV and V of the act.

The Committee invites the public to testify or to submit written testimony, which will be made a part of the official record. Those who wish to testify should contact La Dorsa Willis at (202) 724-8198 before 5p.m. Friday, December 8. Individual public witnesses will be permitted 3 minutes for oral presentation. Organizational representatives will be permitted 5 minutes. Witnesses should bring 16 copies of their testimony to the continued public oversight hearing.
