On November 16, 2004, organizers for the proposed Bank of Georgetown filed an application with the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking to establish a bank under the District of Columbia Banking Code. Pursuant to section 5(b)(1)(B) of the District of Columbia Regional Interstate Banking Act of 1995 (D.C. Official Code § 26-704(b)(1)(B) (2001)), the Commissioner of the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking ("Commissioner") is required to hold a public hearing on the application. The Commissioner hereby gives notice that he will hold a public hearing on the Bank of Georgetown charter application on January 28, 2005, at 10:00 a.m., at the Department of Insurance, Securities and Banking located at First Street, NW, Suite 701, Washington, D.C. 20002.
