Councilmember Vincent B. Orange, Sr., Chairperson of the Committee on Government Operations, announces a Public Hearing on Bill 16-23, the "District of Columbia Summer Youth Employment Act of 2005". The Public Hearing will be held on Monday, February 28, 2005 at 3:30 p.m., in the 5th Floor District of Columbia Council Chamber, John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W. Bill 16-23 authorizes the establishment of programs to provide employment for all District of Columbia youth between the ages of fourteen (14) and twenty-one (21) and requires that the District of Columbia government create a program, within the Department of Employment Services, whose primary mission would be to enroll youth in the Summer Job Program ("SJP") and to actively pursue public-private partnerships with District of Columbia businesses that are capable of hiring District of Columbia youth, domiciled in the District of Columbia.

The public hearing was originally scheduled for Thursday, February 24, 2005.
