To authorize, on an emergency basis, payment to Hawk One Security, Inc., for security services provided to the District of Columbia Public Library without a valid written contract.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Hawk One Security, Inc. Payment Authorization Emergency Act of 2008".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 105(d)(5)(F)(ii) of the District of Columbia Procurement Practices Act of 1985, effective February 21, 1986 (D.C. Law 6-85; D.C. Official Code § 2-301.05(d)(5)(F)(ii)), the Council authorizes the District of Columbia Public Library to pay Hawk One Security, Inc. \$150,860.76 for security services received from October 1, 2006 through May 31, 2007, which were provided without a valid written contract.

To amend, on an emergency basis, section 47-2402 of the District of Columbia Official Code to clarify that stamps may be affixed only to packages of cigarettes whose brands are included in the directory of Tobacco Product Manufacturers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Cigarette Stamp Clarification Emergency Act of 2008".

Sec. 2. The second sentence of section 47-2402(c) of the District of Columbia Official Code is amended to read as follows: "Such stamps shall be affixed to the original packages of cigarettes included in the directory of Tobacco Product Manufacturers maintained pursuant to § 7-1803.03(b) and shall be cancelled in the manner prescribed by the Mayor."





BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the "Dr. Vincent E. Reed Auditorium Designation Emergency Act of 2008".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 401 of the Street and Alley Closing and Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; D.C. Official Code § 9-204.01) ("Act"), and notwithstanding the requirements set forth in section 405 of the Act that no public space shall be named in honor of any living person, the Council designates the auditorium at Benjamin Banneker Academic High School, 800 Euclid Street, N.W., in Ward 1, as the "Dr. Vincent E. Reed Auditorium".

Sec. 3. Transmittal.

The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this resolution, after it becomes effective, to the Mayor.




