The purpose of Bill 17-757 is to increase the maximum compensation for attorneys in neglect and termination of parental rights proceedings. The purpose of Bill 17-768 is to eliminate the requirement that transfer to firefighter shall be to a step and class with a rate of pay closest to but not lower than the employee's rate of pay prior to the transfer; to provide for the participation by specified transferred employees in the Police Officers and Fire Fighters' Retirement Program; and to eliminate the requirement that the transferred employee meet the requirements for entry level firefighters; and for other purposes.
