**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING**

The District of Columbia Taxicab Commission ("Commission"), by its Panel on Rates and Rules, pursuant to the authority set forth under sections 8(b)(1)(J) and 9(b) of the District of Columbia Taxicab Commission Establishment Act of 1985, effective March 25, 1986, (D.C. Law 6-97; D.C. Official Code §§ 50-307(b) (1)(J), and 50-308(b)), hereby gives notice of its proposed rulemaking action taken July 5, 2005, to amend § 102 of Chapter 1 of Title 31 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations ("DCMR"). The proposed rulemaking will amend the date and time of the Commission's regular meetings from the first Tuesday at 9:00 a.m., to the second Wednesday at 10:00 a.m.. Final rulemaking action shall not be taken in less than thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this notice in the D.C. Register.

The following section in 31 DCMR Chapter 1 is amended as follows:

**102            MEETINGS**

102.1            The Commission shall hold regular meetings on the second Wednesday of January, March, May, July, September and November at 10:00 a.m., at the official offices of the Commission, or at any other place as the Chairperson may designate.

Any person desiring to file written comments on the Panel's proposed rulemaking action must do so not later than thirty (30) days after the publication of this notice in the District of Columbia Register. NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

The Director of the Department of Transportation, pursuant to the authority in sections 3, 5(3), and 6 of the Department of Transportation Establishment Act of 2002, effective May 21, 2002 (D.C. Law 14-137; D.C. Official Code §§ 50-921.02, 50-921.04(3) and 50-921.05), and sections 6(a)(1), 6(a)(6) and 6(b) of the District of Columbia Traffic Act, approved March 3, 1925 (43 Stat. 1121; D.C. Official Code § 50-2201.03(a)(1), (a)(6) and (b)), hereby gives notice of the intent to amend the Vehicle and Traffic Regulations (18 DCMR). Final rulemaking action shall be taken in not less than thirty (30) days from the date of publication of this notice in the D.C. Register.

The following rulemaking action is proposed:

Title 18 DCMR, Section 4004, "ONE-WAY STREETS", Subsection 4004.1, (a) Northwest Section, is amended by adding the following to the list of locations where traffic is restricted to one direction of travel:

"On 6<sup>th</sup> Street, N.W., between Cedar Street and Piney Branch Road, for northbound traffic only".

Title 18 DCMR, Section 4008, "STOP SIGNS, Subsection 4008.1, (a) Northwest Section, is amended by deleting the following from the list of locations where STOP signs are placed:

"On 6th Street Street, N.W. so as to stop at Piney Branch Road.
