To approve an amendment to the District of Columbia State Plan for Medicaid Assistance governing liens and adjustments or recoveries, define undue hardship and identify affected services.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Medicaid State Plan Amendment Governing Liens and Adjustments or Recoveries Approval Resolution of 2005".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 1(a) of An Act To enable the District of Columbia to receive Federal financial assistance under title XIX of the Social Security Act for a medical assistance program, and for other purposes, approved December 27, 1967 (81 Stat. 744; D.C. Official Code § 1-307.02), the Council of the District of Columbia approves the proposed amendment to the District of Columbia State Plan for Medical Assistance to define the criteria for estate recoveries and the circumstances where the District would waive recovery based on undue hardship and where recovery is not cost-effective; identify those services for which the Department of Health, Medical Assistance Administration will seek recovery of payments; and identify the collection process and the appeals procedures available to affected parties.

Sec. 3. The Secretary to the Council of the District of Columbia shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, each to the Director of the Department of Health and to the Mayor.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
