1. **Registration**



By the virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422 (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(11) (2001), and pursuant to 19 DCMR §1301.8 (June 2001), it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Commencing September 7, 2005, through September 8, 2005, daily from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m., the streets known as "E" Street, N.W., and Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., between 13th & 14th Streets, N.W., being those streets immediately to the north and south of Freedom Plaza, and the curb lanes on the north and south sides of E Street N.W. between 13th Street and 14th Street N.W., and the north and south curb lanes of "E" Street N.W. between 12th and 13th Street, N.W., adjacent to Freedom Plaza, are hereby designated as special event areas to be used as a senior vending marketplace and senior festival site, and vendor/sponsor set-up areas, and shall be under the authority and use by the D.C. Office on Aging. The said portion of "E" Street shall be closed to motor vehicle traffic except for such vehicles as may be expressly authorized to enter therein, and the said portion of Pennsylvania Avenue shall be partially closed to motor vehicle traffic as necessary to facilitate the loading and offloading of attendees, materials and supplies to Freedom Plaza.
2. The D.C. Office on Aging is authorized to operate said senior festival and senior vending marketplace in this designated special event area, at the times specified.
3. In the event that all or any part of the said senior festival is interrupted by adverse weather conditions on September 7 or 8, 2005, DCOA hereby is authorized to extend the said festival to September 9, 2005, under the terms and conditions described in Paragraph 1 above.






