The Public Roundtable will be held on Monday, December 20, 2004 at 10:00 a.m., in the 5th Floor Council Chamber, John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

Bill 15-977, the "Equitable Voting Rights Amendment Act of 2004" proposes to amend the District of Columbia Election Code of 1955 to define "qualified elector" to include a permanent resident alien in the District of Columbia for the purposes of certain elections.
