The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board will conduct a public hearing to receive comments on a petition to renew the East Dupont Circle Moratorium for six months.

The petition has been filed jointly by the Dupont Circle Citizens Association (DCCA) and the Dupont Circle Merchants and Professionals Association (DCMPA). The petition proposes a moratorium on retailer's class A, B, CN, CR, CT, CX, DN, DR, DT and DX licenses. All hotels, whether present or future, would be exempted. The proposed moratorium area to be covered is approximately 600 feet in all directions from Trio's Restaurant, which is located at the intersection of 17<sup>th</sup> and Q Streets, N.W., Washington, D.C. Class A and B licenses permit the consumption of beer and wine for consumption off-premises only; Class C and D licenses permit the consumption of spirits, beer and wine for consumption on-premises only.

Persons wishing to comment are urged to review the petition prior to the public hearing.
