**Introduction**

FPCS is soliciting proposals from offerors having specific interest and qualifications in the areas identified in this solicitation. Qualification statements and proposals for consideration must contain evidence of the offeror's experience and abilities in the specified area and other disciplines directly related to the proposed work. Other information required by FPCS includes the submission of profiles and resumes of the staff to be assigned to the projects, references, illustrative examples of similar work performed, and any other requested information which will clearly demonstrate the offeror's expertise in the area of this solicitation.

A selection committee will review and evaluate all qualification statements and may request offerors to make oral presentations. The selection committee will rely on the qualification statements in selection of finalists and, therefore, offerors should emphasize specific information considered pertinent to this solicitation and submit all information requested.

**Project Description**

The Friendship Public Charter School is comprised of four campuses with a total enrollment of approximately 3,100 students, including a special education enrollment of approximately 10 percent. Each campus has a special education staff and a combination of campus-specific related service providers as well as related service providers who are shared across campuses. As charter schools in the District of Columbia were only recently able to access Medicaid reimbursements for special education related services, there is a need to not only provide Medicaid billing services but also to provide software, staff training and intensive monitoring to ensure that all records are in compliance with Medicaid requirements. In addition, the consultant would be required to assist each campus in gathering the appropriate Medicaid insurance provider information from parents and students who qualify.

All offerors should understand that support must be provided to each campus to maximize Medicaid reimbursement and provide support in the areas of professional development, records management, and data warehousing (preferably through an approved software package such as Welligent). This is an immediate need. Therefore, all offerors are expected to demonstrate that they have the existing capacity to provide the aforementioned services.

FPCS desires to have these services commence in December 2004.
