CONSIDERATION OF TEMPORARY LEGISLATION

B15-1089, "Certificate of Title Excise Tax Exemption Temporary Amendment Act of 2004", **B15-1097**, "Real Property Disposition Economic Analysis Second Temporary Amendment Act of 2004", **B15-1099**, "Public Congestion and Venue Protection Temporary Amendment Act of 2004", **B15-1109**, "Estate and Inheritance Tax Clarification Temporary Act of 2004", **B15-1111**, "Bonus Depreciation De-Coupling from the Internal Revenue Code Temporary Act of 2004", **B15-1123**, "District Government Reemployed Annuitant Offset Alternative Temporary Amendment Act of 2004", **B15-1117**, Child and Youth, Safety and Health Omnibus Temporary Amendment Act of 2004", and **B15-1128**, "School Safety and Security Contracting Procedures Temporary Act of 2004", were adopted on first reading on November 9, 2004.
