The Committee held a hearing in October 2007, and the purpose of this oversight hearing is to conduct further review of the Enforcement and Effectiveness of the Language Access Act so that problems may be addressed and areas of strength can continue to be built upon for future implementation of the provisions outlined in the Act and discuss the changes that have been made to foster compliance with the Act.
