The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the resolution listed below to disapprove CA 17-537, proposed contract was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 2, 2008.

The proposed contract with Optimal Solutions & Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$150,000,000 to obtain the services of a Contractor to manage Information Technology Staff Augmentation services for the District by assembling a network of Subcontracting Vendors.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 45 days, including Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays. If a resolution of approval or disapproval is not adopted by the Council during this time, the proposed contract will be deemed approved on the 46<sup>th</sup> day.
