The purpose of the Public Oversight Roundtable is to formally receive an assessment of the general operations of the District of Columbia government from the District of Columbia City Administrator/ Deputy Mayor, Robert C. Bobb. The Committee on Government Operations will place special emphasis on the following issue areas: the various programmatic, financial, administrative, and personnel issues, within the District of Columbia government as identified by the Office of the City Administrator; initiatives and/or plans that have been developed and implemented to address the identified issues; updates concerning the District of Columbia Youth Services Administration (reforms made to date, and additional plans for reform); the District of Columbia Department of Health (reforms made to date, and additional plans for reform); the District of Columbia Office of Contracting and Procurement (an update on the various issues identified with the District’s contracting and procurement procedures and proposals for reform (*statutory, regulatory, administrative and procedural reforms*)); the status of the executive’s efforts to attract major league baseball to the District of Columbia; updates on D.C. Act 15-229, the “National Capital Medical Center Memorandum of Understanding Approval Act of 2004”; the selection status of the District of Columbia Inspector General; updates relative to internal personnel reforms within the Office of the

City Administrator, and the Executive Office of the Mayor; and a status report on plans or actions that have been taken to restructure District agencies and the impact such plans have had or propose to have on the mandated operations of the respective agency.
