The Department of Health, Medical Assistance Administration, Office of Managed Care pursuant to the Balanced Budget Act of 1997 as amended, Federal Code of Regulation 42 CFR 438.202, is required to develop a written quality strategy plan along with the input of Medicaid beneficiaries and stakeholders to assess and improve the quality of Medicaid managed care and prepaid inpatient health services to beneficiaries in the District of Columbia. The Continuous Quality Improvement Plan (herein known as the "Plan") is the result of this collaborative quality strategic planning. The purpose of the Plan is to ensure that beneficiaries receiving care and services under the District of Columbia Healthy Families Program (DCHFP) and the Child and Adolescent Supplemental Security Income Program (CASSIP) have access to appropriate, essential, quality, and cost-effective health care services. The Plan describes the quality monitoring and oversight strategies of the District's Medicaid managed care organizations for the provision of care to Medicaid beneficiaries. Under Federal regulations, the Continuous Quality Improvement Plan must be made available for public comment.

Official Code § 2-505, and 20 DCMR § 206, the Air Quality Division (AQD) of the Environmental Health Administration located at 51 N Street, N.E., Washington, D.C., intends to issue a permit to Roubin & Janeiro to construct a 225 ton per hour asphalt plant at the Roubin & Janeiro Plant, located at 60 P Street, S.E., Washington, DC 20003.

The asphalt plant includes an ADM dryer, Model MM225, with an ADM mixer, Model MM225; an ADM baghouse, Model BHS525-10 and other accessories is being permitted per submitted plans and specifications.

The application to construct an asphalt plant and the proposed construction permit are available for public inspection at AQD and copies may be made between the hours of 8:15 A.M. and 4:45 P.M. **NOTICE OF AMENDMENTS TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE PLAN FOR
THE SECTION 8 CERTIFICATE AND HOUSING CHOICE VOUCHER PROGRAM**

The Board of Commissioners of the District of Columbia Housing Authority has adopted amendments to the Administrative Plan for the Section 8 Certificate and Housing Choice Voucher Program. Chapter 2, "About the Authority," Subsection A, "Family Outreach," was amended to delete outdated references to Single Room Occupancy Units. Chapter 4, "Establishing Preferences and Maintaining the Waiting List," Section E.ii, "Local Preference Definitions," was amended to add transitional Single Room Occupancy units to the definition of Substandard Housing and to add families living in transitional Single Room Occupancy units to the definition of Homeless Families. These amendments became effective upon adoption by the Board of Commissioners on September 15, 2004.
