THIS CASE IS OF INTEREST TO ANC 6C

On July 2, 2004, the Office of Zoning received an application from the Office of Planning (the "applicant") for approval of a new subarea of the Downtown Development District Zone in certain squares of the Mount Vernon Triangle area of northwest Washington and for a map amendment for Square 483.

The Mount Vernon Triangle is bounded by Massachusetts Avenue, New York Avenue, 7th Street, and New Jersey Avenue, N.W.

The proposed district would be applied to an area centering on the intersection of 5th and K Streets, N.W. It would extend along 5th Street from Eye Street to New York Avenue, and along K Street from 4th Street to 7th Street. It would apply to all of or portions of Squares 451, 484W, 483, 484, 515, and 516. The applicant is also requesting a map amendment to rezone Square 483 from C-3-C to DD/C-3-C. This request is not inconsistent with the Comprehensive Plan of the District of Columbia.

On June 15, 2004, the Office of Zoning received an application from the District of Columbia Water and Sewer Authority (the “applicant”) for approval of a consolidated planned unit development for the above-referenced property.

The property that is the subject of this application consists of a portion of Parcel 253, in Southwest Washington, D.C. (Ward 8), with a street address of 4500 Overlook Drive, S.W. The property is currently zoned C-M-3.

The applicant proposes to construct biosolids reduction and stabilization facilities known as the Egg-Shaped Digesters Facility at the Blue Plains Advanced Wastewater Treatment Plant. This request is not inconsistent with the Comprehensive Plan of the District of Columbia.
