NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted for approval to the Council by the Interim Superintendent was filed in the Office of the Secretary on June 3, 2004. A Contract Summary for the proposed contract, CAS 15-237, was filed in the Office of the Secretary on May 26, 2004. The proposed contract in the amount of \$9,141,044.71 with Watkins Security Agency of D.C., Inc. to provide security and related services to District of Columbia Public Schools was filed on June 4, 2004. The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 15 days, excluding Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays. If a resolution of approval or disapproval is not adopted by the Council during this time, the proposed contract will be deemed approved on June 24, 2004.
