NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted for approval to the Council by the Mayor was filed in the Office of the Secretary on June 10, 2004. A Contract Summary for the proposed contract, CAS 15-241, was filed in the Office of the Secretary on June 7, 2004. The proposed contract in the amount of \$42,890,236.00 with Jair Lynch/Tompkins Joint Venture to construct the Unified Communication Center (UCC), including a long span call center, health facility, food services facilities, administrative offices, special use conferencing areas, and child care facility was filed on June 15, 2004. The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 15 days, excluding Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays. If a resolution of approval or disapproval is not adopted by the Council during this time, the proposed contract will be deemed approved on July 8, 2004.
