RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Transfer of Jurisdiction of the New York Avenue Animal Shelter Expansion Site Resolution of 2004".

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 1 of An Act to Authorize the Transfer of Jurisdiction Over Public Land in the District of Columbia, approved May 20, 1932 (47 Stat. 161; D.C. (b) The owners of certain multi-family dwellings such as apartment buildings, condominium buildings, and cooperative buildings, who can receive tests kits for their buildings, have apparently been refusing to request kits from WASA to test the lead level of the tap water in their buildings after having been requested to do so by a resident of the building.

(c) WASA has been understandably hesitant to test potentially every unit in a multi-family dwelling because the building is serviced by the same main water line and the cost of sampling every unit would be high and would ultimately be passed on to all ratepayers.

(d) It is, therefore, necessary to enact emergency legislation to authorize the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to require the owner of a multi-family dwelling to order a lead level test kit and to test the building's tap water upon receiving a written request from a

building resident so that all District residents have an opportunity to ensure that their water is safe to drink.
