**Notice of Reprogramming Request**

Pursuant to DC Code Sec 47-361-et.seq of the Reprogramming Policy Act of 1990, the Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the Mayor has transmitted the following reprogramming request(s).

A reprogramming will become effective on the 15<sup>th</sup> day after official receipt unless a Member of the Council files a notice of disapproval of the request which extends the Council's review period to 30 days. If such notice is given, a reprogramming will become effective on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after its official receipt unless a resolution of approval or disapproval is adopted by the Council prior to that time.

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**Reprog. 17-140:** Request to reprogram \$100,000 of local budget authority from the District of Columbia Department of Human Resources (DCHR) to the Board of Elections and Ethics was filed in the Chairman's Office on August 1, 2008. This reprogramming will provide budget authority to cover costs associated with the September 9, 2008 election, including equipment and Memorandums of Understanding with other agencies that support the election.

**Reprog. 17-141:** Request to reprogram \$515,103 of capital budget authority from the Office of Property Management's (OPM) project for the Materials Testing Lab to the District Department of Transportation's (DDOT) project for Farragut Street Maintenance Facilities was filed in the Chairman's Office on August 1, 2008. The reprogramming is needed for District Department of Transportation to move forward with its plans for the Farragut Maintenance Facilities.

**Reprog. 17-142:** Request to reprogram \$353,500 of local budget authority consisting of transferring \$200,000 from the Office of the Secretary to the Board of Elections and Ethics (BOEE) and reallocating \$153,500 of existing budget authority within the Board of Elections and Ethics was filed in the Chairman's Office on August 1, 2008. This reprogramming will provide budget authority to cover costs associated with the September 9, 2008 primary election, to include overtime, printing, and Election Day contracting support; and to also provide funding for retirement incentives.

**Reprog. 17-143:** Request to reprogram \$6,079,788 of Local funds budget from the agencies as follows: the District of Columbia Public Charter Schools (DCPCS) in the amount of \$3,035,000, the Repayment of Loans and Interest account in the amount of \$2,355,644, and the Office of the City Administrator (OCA) in the amount of \$689,144, to the Child and Family Services Agency (CFSA) in the Human Support Services appropriation title was filed in the Chairman's Office on August 1, 2008. This reprogramming will address a spending pressure in CFSA that was caused by an increase in the volume of cases referred to the agency for investigation.
