NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted to the Council by the Mayor for approval was filed in the Office of the Secretary on March 23, 2004. The proposed contract (CA 15-196) filed in the office of the Secretary on March 31, 2004, with Tech, USA, Inc. in the amount of \$948,442.19 would retroactively approve an increase of the base contract to \$1,947,620.18. The contract was executed on March 29, 2000, for Information Services in the amount of \$999,999.99. The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 15 days, excluding Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays. If a resolution of approval or disapproval is not adopted by the Council during this time, the proposed contract will be deemed approved on April 22, 2004.
