Councilmember Carol Schwartz, Chairperson of the Committee on Workforce Development and Government Operations, announces a Public Hearing on Bill 17-856, "Contract No. DCAM-2006-C-0033 Approval and Payment Authorization Act of 2008" and Bill 17-857, "Contract No. DCAM-2007-C-0092 Change Orders Approval and Payment Authorization Act of 2008". Bill 17-857 would approve Contract No. DCAM-2007-C-0092 with Minkoff Company, Inc. to replace the Eastern Market roof and authorize payment for the services received and to be received under that contract.

Councilmember Phil Mendelson, Chairperson of the Committee on Public Safety and the Judiciary, announces a second public hearing on Bill 17-843, the "Firearms Control Amendment Act of 2008". The hearing will be held on Wednesday, October 1, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. in the 5th Floor Chamber of the John A. Wilson Building.

The stated purpose of Bill 17-843 is to amend the Firearms Control Regulations Act of 1975 to repeal the prohibition on the registration of pistols, to require a ballistics record for each registered pistol, to require a waiting period when registering a firearm, and to establish a self-defense exception to the requirement for safe storage of firearms in the home.

On July 15th, the Council passed Bill 17-886, the "Firearms Control Emergency Amendment Act of 2008." This bill amends, on an emergency basis, the Firearms Control Regulations Act of 1975 to provide for a registration process for pistols for use in self-defense within the home, to authorize the Chief of the Metropolitan Police Department to require a ballistics identification procedure for registered pistols, to set a one pistol registration per person policy for a period of 90 days, to clarify the firearm storage requirements, and to include an exemption from those requirements for the use of a firearm for self-defense in the registered owner's home, and to provide that a registered pistol owner shall not be required to obtain a license to carry the pistol within the registered pistol owner's home.

The Committee held the first public hearing on Bill 17-843 on September 18th. The purpose of the second hearing is to receive testimony from **invited witnesses only** on Bill 17-843 and related issue regarding the 1975 Act.
