NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted to the Council by the Mayor for approval was filed in the Office of the Secretary on February 27, 2004. A Contract Summary for the proposed contract, CAS 15-174, was filed in the Office of the Secretary on February 19, 2004. The proposed contract in the amount of \$96, 000,000.00 with Greater Southeast Community Hospital Corporation I, D.C. Chartered Health Plan, Inc., Unity Health Care, Inc., Children's National Medical Center, and the George Washington University Hospital is to provide health care services to the uninsured on behalf of the Department of Health. Upon receipt of the proposed contract, the disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 15 days, excluding Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays.
