Councilmember Harold Brazil, chairperson of the Committee on Economic Development, announces a public hearing on Bill 15-726, "Washington Convention Center Authority Advisory Committee Amendment Act of 2004". The hearing will be held at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 17, 2004, in Room 412 of 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW (John A. Wilson Building).

Bill 15-726, "Washington Convention Center Authority Advisory Committee Amendment Act of 2004", if approved, would amend the Washington Convention Center Authority Act of 1994 to reconstitute the Washington Convention Center Authority Advisory Committee ("WCCAAC"). Bill 15-726 modifies the membership and goals of the WCCAAC to take into account that the Convention Center is no longer in the planning or construction phases. The new advisory group would be made up of 11 members who will help advise the Washington Convention Center Authority on operational issues such as pedestrian movement projects, transportation and parking issues, and economic development objectives.

Each person who wishes to present oral testimony at the hearing must provide his or her name, address, and telephone number, as well as the name of the organization he or she represents (if any) to David L.
