

NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted to the Council by the Mayor for approval was filed in the Office of the Secretary on March 2, 2004. A Contract Summary for the proposed contract, CAS 15-178, was filed in the Office of the Secretary on February 27, 2004. The proposed multi-year contract in the amount of \$45,648,967.22 with Watkins Security Agency of Washington, D.C. to provide security services for the Public Schools. Upon receipt of the proposed contract, the disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 15 days, excluding Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays.

\$45,648,967.22 to provide security services to D.C. Public Schools to the Council for review and 2
approval on February 27, 2004. 3
